**FAVORSKI, Nikita Vladimirovich.** Born 1915. Studied at Moscow Polygraphic Institute 1933-38. Active in Moscow 1930s. Began exhibiting no later than 1934. Also a monumentalist. Died 1941.

FAVORSKI, Vladimir Andreevich. Born in Moscow 1886. Studied at K. F. Yuon and I. O. Dudin's studio-school, Moscow, 1903-04(05?); S. Hollosy's SCHOOL, Munich, 1906-07; Moscow University (art history) 1907-12/13? Active in Moscow. Began exhibiting 1911. Member of MTKH; MAKOVETS; FOUR ARTS from 1924 (founder member). Important shows include 'Anti-Imperialist Exhibition', Moscow, 1931: 'ARTISTS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION OVER FIF-TEEN YEARS', Leningrad, 1932; 'ARTISTS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION OVER FIFTEEN YEARS', Moscow, 1933: 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1947; 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1950; 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1952; 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1955. Taught at Moscow FREE ART STUDIOS/VKHUTEMAS/VKHUTEIN 1918-19, 1921/23?-29/30? (rector 1923-25/26?); Moscow POLYGRAPHIC INSTITUTE 1930(31?)-34; 1905 ART TEKHNIKUM early 1930s; Moscow ART INSTITUTE 1934/35?-38; Institute of Painting, Sculpture and ARCHITECTURE (consultant on monumental painting) 1936-41; MIPIDI 1942(43?)-48. Became a Soviet academician. Best known as a graphic artist. Also a monumentalist, theatre artist, sculptor. An influential teacher in the 1920s and also a source of inspiration to young artists of the 1950s. Died in Moscow 1964.

FEDDER (FEDDERS), Yuli Ivanovich (Bogdanovich). Born in Kokengauzen? (Latvia) 1838. Studied in Dusseldorf; at Imperial ACADEMY OF ARTS 1856(62?)-74(75?). Active in (Latvia). Specialised in landscapes. Became an academician 1880. Died 1909.

**FEDDERS, Petr Yulievich.** Studied at Imperial ACADEMY OF ARTS until 1892.

FEDER, Adolf. Born in Odessa (Ukraine) 1886. Studied at Odessa Art College; at art school in Geneva; in Paris (including in H. Matisse's studio) from 1908. Active in Berlin 1906; Geneva, Switzerland; Paris from c. 1908. Also a graphic artist. Died in Auschwitz, Poland, 1943.

FEDORCHENKO, Kirill Danilovich. Born in Armavir. Kuban reg.. 1896. Studied at 1. 1. Mashkov's studio-school. Moscow; Moscow College of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture 1913-18. Active in Armavir 1918-19; Tuapse, Kuban reg.; Constantinople; Italy: Paris: Italy again 1920; Moscow from 1920/21?; Tashkent, Uzbekistan, 1921-22; Moscow thereafter (in Kiev, Ukraine, 1926-29). Member of *AKHR* from 1930. Exhibited with *AKHRR* 1926 (ex. 8). Important shows include 'ARTISTS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION OVER FIFTEEN YEARS'. Moscow, 1933. Taught at Kiev Art Institute 1926-29.

**FEDORCHUK, Vasili Fedorovich.** Born 1917. Studied at Moscow Municipal Studio for Invalids of the Great Patriotic War until 1954. Active in Moscow.

**FEDORENKO, Boris Mikhailovich.** Born 1946. Active in Kiev, Ukraine.

**FEDORENKO**, **Nikolai Mikhailovich**. Born in Rogozino, Vitebsk pr., Belorussia, 1922. Studied in art studio. Mogilev, 1938-41. Active in Mogilev, Belorussia. Began exhibiting 1947. Specialised in lyrical and industrial landscapes.

**FEDORENKO, Svyatoslav Nikolaevich.** Born 1946. Active in Minsk, Belorussia.

**FEDORICHEVA, Mariya Aleksandrovna.** Born 1895. Active in Leningrad. Member of *KRUG* from 1926 (founder member). Important shows include 'ARTISTS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION OVER FIFTEEN YEARS', Leningrad, 1932. Died c. 1970.

FEDOROV, Aleksei Ivanovich. Born in Moscow 1951. Studied at Moscow Intermediate Art School until 1969; at SURIKOV INSTITUTE until 1975; in creative studios of USSR Academy of Arts, Moscow?, 1978-81. Active in Moscow. Began exhibiting 1975. Member of GREKOV STUDIO from 1983.

**FEDOROV, Aleksei Konstantinovich.** Born 1924. Active in Riga, Latvia.

FEDOROV, Aleksei Viktorovich. Born 1927. Studied at Leningrad Intermediate Art School 1933-41; REPIN INSTITUTE from 1948. Active in Leningrad. Important shows include 'Soviet Russia', Moscow, 1960. *Plate 66*.

FEDOROV, Boris Fedorovich. Born in Samara 1922. Studied at REPIN INSTITUTE. Active in Leningrad. Important shows include 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1951; 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1952; 'All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1955; 'Soviet Russia', Moscow, 1960. Specialised in military subjects. Well-known works include *The Morning of the Tank Drivers* (1952-54). Died 1984.

**FEDOROV, Dmitri Stepanovich.** Born 1890. Active in Ekaterinodar/Krasnodar. Died in period 1958-67.

FEDOROV, German Vasilevich. Born in Moscow 1885(86?). Studied at (STROGANOV COLLEGE 1902-04?); (I. I. Mashkov's studio-school, Moscow?): Mos-COW COLLEGE OF PAINTING, SCULPTURE AND ARCHI-TECTURE 1902(03?)-11. Active in Moscow. Member of Jack of Diamonds 1911/12?-16/17?; World of ART 1917-21: Moscow Painters 1925-26 (founder member); AKHRR 1924/26?-28?; OMKH 1928-32. Exhibited with JACK OF DIAMONDS 1911-17: WORLD OF ART 1917; AKHRR 1926 (ex. 8). Important shows include 'First Russian Art Exhibition', Berlin. 1922; 'ARTISTS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION OVER FIF-TEEN YEARS', Leningrad, 1932; 'ARTISTS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION OVER FIFTEEN YEARS'. MOSCOW. 1933. Painted landscapes, still-lifes, portraits, and from c. 1922 - industrial landscapes. Taught at Moscow Free Art Studios/VKhuTeMas 1918-c. 1930: 1905 ART TEKHNIKUM and Moscow POLYGRAPHIC IN-STITUTE from 1932. Decorated festivals 1918. Influenced by Moscow cezannists. Died in Moscow 1976.

**FEDOROV, Konstantin Alekseevich.** Born 1907. Active in Moscow. Died in period 1958-67.

FEDOROV, Leonid Aleksandrovich. Born 1892. Active in Peski, near Kolomna, Moscow reg. Exhibited with MTKH 1918. Died 1960.

FEDOROV, M. G. - see ROSHAL, M. G.

FEDOROV, Mitrofan Semenovich. Born in Voronezh pr. 1870/73? Studied at Imperial ACADE-MY OF ARTS 1894-1901. Active in Kharkov, Ukraine, 1902-34; Leningrad from 1934. Exhibited with Koltso, Kharkov. Taught at Kharkov School of Drawing and Painting/Art College 1902-13; Kharkov Art Institute 1925-34; INSTITUTE OF PAINTING, SCULPTURE AND ARCHITECTURE 1934-37. Died in Leningrad 1942.

**FEDOROV, Nikolai Alekseevich.** Born 1922. Active in Tomsk.

FEDOROV, Revel Fedorovich. Born in Bolshic Chaki, Chuvashia, 1929. Studied at Cheboksary Art College 1946-55 (military service 1950-53); Kharkov Art Institute 1957-63. Active in Kaliningrad 1955-c. 1957; Cheboksary, Chuvashia, thereafter. Taught at intermediate school no. 2, Kaliningrad, 1955-57; Cheboksary Teacher-Training Institute from 1964. Chairman of Chuvashian artists' union 1981-87. Best known as a graphic artist. Also a monumentalist.

FEDOROV, Sergei Stepanovich. Born in Omsk 1927. Studied at Moscow Higher Arts and Crafts College 1945-47, mid-1950s-1961 (study interrupted by arrest). Active in Moscow. Taught at Moscow Higher Arts and Crafts College from 1961.

**FEDOROV, Stanislav Vasilevich.** Born 1937. Active in Kuibyshev.

**FEDOROV, Valentin Pavlovich.** Born 1895. Active in Irkutsk. Died 1920.

**FEDOROV, Vasili Fedorovich.** Active in Leningrad. Important shows include 'INDUSTRY OF SOCIALISM', Moscow, 1939.

FEDOROV, Viktor Kronidovich. Born in Kazan, Tataria, 1940. Studied at Kazan Art College 1954-59; REPIN INSTITUTE 1959-66. Active in Kazan. Important shows include 'Soviet Russia', Moscow, 1960. Also a monumentalist, graphic artist.

**FEDOROV, Vladimir Aleksandrovich.** Born 1920. Active in Kirovograd, Ukraine. Died 1980s.

**FEDOROV, Vladimir Alekseevich.** Born 1939. Studied at Krasnoyarsk Art College 1965-69. Active in Krasnoyarsk. Began exhibiting 1965.

**FEDOROV, Vladimir Fedorovich.** Born in Moscow 1933. Studied under A. M. Gritsai. Specialised in landscapes. *Plate 67*.

FEDOROV, Vladislav Georgievich. Born in Tula 1924. Studied at Moscow Intermediate Art School until 1941; Surikov Institute until 1950. Active in Moscow. Began exhibiting 1951. Painted Lenin subjects, country subjects, landscapes. Died 1993.

FEDOROV, Vyacheslav Andreevich. Born in Ivanovo-Voznesensk pr. 1918. Studied at Ivanovo Art College 1934-39; Institute of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture/Repin Institute 1943-50. Active in Ivanovo. Began exhibiting no later than 1951. Important shows include ('All-Union Art Exhibition', Moscow, 1955?); 'Soviet Russia', Moscow, 1960. Specialised in landscapes. Died in Zhelnikha, Kalinin reg., 1980s.

**FEDOROV, Yakov.** Studied at Imperial ACADEMY OF ARTS 1856-68. Died 1911.

**FEDOROV-DAVYDOV, Aleksei Aleksandrovich.** Born in Moscow 1900. Studied at Kazan University until 1923; at institute of archaeology and art, Moscow, as post-grad. until 1928. Active in Moscow. Best known as an art critic and art his-
